

### **Christian John Hunt Memorial Fund**

This fund was established to contribute to the study of geography through the Geography Program in the Geosciences Department at Oregon State University, or its successors. The fund will support students who have demonstrated an interest in and are pursuing studies to achieve an undergraduate degree in geography from the department. Since the first award was made in 1976, over 60 students have received Hunt scholarships.

#### Eligibility requirements:

1. To be eligible for a **scholarship** from the fund, the student **must be pursuing studies to achieve an undergraduate degree in geography**.
2. The student must have a **high degree of personal integrity**, reflecting honesty and respect for other people.
3. Recipients are primarily to be from middle income families and have established **a record that portends career success**.
4. Awards are primarily intended **for students who cannot qualify for assistance or scholarships through exceptionally high grade point achievement or low income status**.
5. The student must demonstrate a **keen interest in the study of geography** particularly in areas represented by the department. The students' potential will be a key factor for consideration.

#### Awards:

1. Scholarship awards are made in the spring for the following academic year.
2. The amount of the scholarship or grant will be determined by the selection committee, usually \$500 - \$1,500 per year. Two to three awards may be made per year.
3. Scholarship or grant awards will be disbursed in three increments, one-third each term.

#### To apply:

1. Complete an application form.
2. Respond to the following three questions:
  - a. What are your annual expenses and income? Briefly itemize your expenses and income for the year.
  - b. What are your plans upon completion of a Bachelor's degree?
  - c. Why should the Geography Program make this award to you, and how will it be used?
